

Legal Internships Summer 2023

RMIAN is offering <u>two full-time, PAID summer internships</u> for current law students during Summer 2023. Interns will:

- gain practical, hands-on knowledge about the immigration legal system and its intersection with other legal fields
- work closely with staff in the Children's Program or the Detention Program
- observe and/or participate in hearings before the Denver or Aurora Immigration Courts
- experience the work environment in a nonprofit legal services organization.

Location:	Westminster, CO
Hours:	Full-time (40 hours/week)
Duration:	at least 10 weeks between May and August
Compensation:	\$5000 stipend (subject to withholding)

RMIAN is a nonprofit organization that provides free immigration legal services to individuals in immigration detention and to children and their families throughout Colorado. RMIAN is comprised of three substantive pillars: (1) the Detention Program advocates on behalf of people held at the privately-owned civil immigration detention facility located in Aurora, Colorado; (2) the Children's Program provides free legal representation to immigrant children and their families who have experienced abuse, neglect, abandonment, trafficking and violence; and (3) the Social Services Project offers wrap-around support to people who are detained, formerly detained, or children and families in need of tools to navigate accessing services in the community.

RMIAN is committed to providing educational opportunities for law students interested in pursuing professions in the field of immigration advocacy.
