Arrival at detention center. ICE can assign a bond.

You can appeal to the Board of Immigration Appeals. You can only go back to the immigration judge if your circumstances have changed substantially.



The money is returned to the person who paid the bond.

*At the end of the case*

You continue to fight your case outside of detention.



If you live in Colorado or Wyoming your case Will be transferred to the Denver Immigration Court but you will still need to do a Change of Address.

If you live in another state, you will have to do a Change of Address and file a Change of Venue.
