If you live in Colorado or Wyoming your case Will be transferred to the Denver Immigration Court but you will still need to do a Change of Address.

At the end of the case

If you live in another state, you will have to do a Change of Address and file a Change of Venue.

If you indicate that the you want the Immigration Judge to review your bond, the court will assign you a bond hearing.

If you did not indicate that you want the judge to review your bond, you must file a petition with the immigration court.
